In the Kawarthas we reel from one extreme weather event to another. After a bitterly cold and snowy winter an ice storm caused a state of emergency with widespread destruction and extended power loss throughout our communities. Summer followed with wave after wave of heat and smoke-filled air. Unending drought dried our farmers' ponds and creeks, crisped our crops, and forced water restrictions in our communities. Who knows what the autumn storms will bring.

In the meantime we struggle with the damage costs, the health costs, and the rising cost of living. Extreme heat is deadly, especially for seniors, young children, outdoor workers and people on low incomes. Smoke-filled air is a major health hazard for infants, children and older people.

The climate crisis is driving up prices we pay for food, energy, and utilities. And now insurance companies are using it to hike the premiums they charge us. We are paying more for less while the rich get richer. Our governments fail to protect us. They haven't listened to us. They have ignored Indigenous treaty rights. And they have enacted laws that will make things worse.
